Consult Military OneSource as your first step. Call 800-342-9647 for 24/7 help, and connect to a Military OneSource adoption consultant, who can provide guidance on beginning the adoption process, military financial assistance and much more. It's free!

- 1. **Reducing expenses**. Thanks to the <u>Department of Defense Adoption Reimbursement Policy</u>, you can claim up to \$2,000 per child and \$5,000 per calendar year in reimbursement for certain adoption expenses.
- 2. **Obtaining leave**. Service members may be eligible for 21 days of non-chargeable adoption leave.
- 3. **Getting health insurance**. Children are automatically covered under TRICARE, but after a certain amount of time—the time period varies based on your TRICARE plan—the parent must submit an enrollment application to maintain coverage.
